



Middle Valley Soccer Academy Fee Structure (2015-2016)

To participate in our programs, players must use our online registration system at www.mvsacademy.com to register prior to the beginning of each season, select the programs they wish to participate in, and arrange for payment of applicable club fees. For your convenience, club fees can be paid online by debit card or credit card.

The overall MVSA structure consists of these programs:

AGE RANGE	PROGRAM	PROGRAM DESCRIPTION
U4-U8	DEVELOPMENTAL	All players in this age range are assigned to this program structure by default. It is fundamentally designed to provide players with a quality learning environment and systematically prepare them for future stages. The Developmental program consists of a mixture of both beginners and experienced players; however, all players have access to the same developmental training opportunities.
U6-U12	CHALLENGE (supplemental)	This supplemental program is designed to provide U6-U12 players with more challenging instruction and additional training opportunities. Challenge sessions will be offered once per week (on average) during the season. All training will be led by Select coaches and other licensed instructors. There is no addition cost for Challenge program training.
U6-U8	IDENTIFICATION (optional)	This optional program would be best described as a “select prep” program for players interested in playing Select beginning their U9 year. It is available to U6-U8 players through a partnership agreement with the Chattanooga Football Club Academy (CFCA). These players are guaranteed instruction from licensed coaches during training and games. For more information on this program (including participation costs), go to www.chattanoogasoccer.com
U9 & older	SELECT	Beginning the U9 year, players will have the option of participating in either the Recreational or Select programs. Players may enter into Select program by invitation only. This means that players are “selected” by the Director, or earn a spot during open evaluation sessions. These players are guaranteed instructing from licensed coaches during training and games.
U9 & older	RECREATIONAL	Beginning the U9 year, players not participating in Select are welcome to participate in Recreational soccer. This is a more traditional program with parent-volunteers providing instruction to players using standard curriculum and other training tools. Challenge training and other supplemental instruction will be offered and available to help meet developmental needs.

MVSA FEE STRUCTURE

Developmental Program

8-10 Weeks – offered each Spring & Fall

Program	Age Range	Club Fee
Developmental (3v3)	U4-U5	\$75
Developmental (4v4/5v5)	U6-U8	\$95

Club Fees go toward:

- 1) Registration and insurance coverage with Tennessee State Soccer Association (TSSA)
- 2) General funds (water/irrigation, electricity, trash, unscheduled maintenance, etc)
- 3) Field usage/maintenance (fertilization, mowing, field line paint, goals, nets, etc)
- 4) Team jersey
- 5) Referees (U6 and older)
- 6) Player awards

Select Program

Yearly program – Offered from August-November and February to May

Program	Age range	Club Fee
Select	U9 and older	\$390 (for entire year of instruction)

NOTES:

- Club fees go toward: registration (Division 3) and insurance with TSSA, guaranteed instruction from USSF/NSCAA licensed coaches, MVYA general funds, field usage/maintenance, goalkeeping and supplemental training.
- Additional costs for Select players:
 - Team Fees go toward: referees for select games, tournament/event entry, training equipment (cones, pinnies), etc. This will vary with each team but typically are within \$50-150 per range for each fall/spring season.
 - Select uniform package (\$89 for two jerseys, one shorts, two pairs of socks)

Program	Age Range	Club Fee
Recreational	U9 and older	\$95

Club Fees go toward:

- 1) Registration (Division 4) and insurance coverage with Tennessee State Soccer Association (TSSA)
- 2) Park general funds (water/irrigation, electricity, trash, unscheduled maintenance, etc)
- 3) Field usage/maintenance (fertilization, mowing, field line paint, goals, nets, etc)
- 4) Team jersey
- 5) Referees (approx. 8 games per season)
